<u>Improving Hospital Discharge – Carers Consultation Group</u>

The local NHS and Herts County Council (HCC) are working together to improve peoples' experience of hospital discharge.

This includes situations where someone:

- returns home without the need for a care package,
- returns home with an existing or new care package,
- has a period of residential rehabilitation,
- returns to or enters residential care.

We want to make sure that unpaid carers have the chance to influence this work, so we are setting up a **Carers Discharge Group** to comment on any proposals and to raise issues.
