

Opportunity to feature in the Greensand Country Celebration Film

Do you have a favourite view within Greensand Country which you'd like to share?

Would you like to feature in the Greensand Country short film?

If so, then we would love to hear from you!

Overview

Film company, RYG Films, have been commissioned by Greensand Country Landscape to create a short film to celebrate Greensand Country. The film will bring the area to life and tell the story of its geology, landscape heritage and those who have lived and worked on the land. The film will feature premiere in May 2021 as part of the Greensand Country Festival. The film will also feature those who love the landscape today.

What we need

- A 20 second clip of you filmed standing or sitting still in a location anywhere found within Greensand Country
- The film footage needs to be shot in landscape (not portrait)

What do you need to do?

- Use your mobile phone to capture the footage
- Film in daylight hours
- Film in the highest quality/resolution on your camera or mobile. The minimum size we can use is **HD 1,920 x 1,080**. The options can be found in 'camera settings'
- Set the framing of the shot to encompass your whole body in the centre of the frame, with the scenery to your sides and above you (as per the example above)
- Aim to have at least three metres between you and the scene behind you
- Use a tripod or someone to film you in position
- Ensure the footage is at least 20 seconds long (any shorter and it won't be able to be included)
- Film one person at a time.

Other notes

- You can use the same location for different people
- We won't be using the audio, so don't worry about any background noise
