## Further updates to JIG 1/2 and JIG 4 checklists to be released in FOS

JIG is pleased to announce that updated versions of its JIG 1/2 and JIG 4 checklists will be released in JITS/FOS on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020. Please note that this Newsflash is principally intended for JITS users with Inspector, Site Manager and Area Manager access rights.

Please be aware of the following important information which is particularly relevant to JIG Inspectors:

- Going forward, all JIG inspections in JITS/FOS system which are progressed from "Unscheduled" and/or "Scheduled" to "In Progress" status will be brought in the system against the new versions of the JIG 1/2 and JIG 4 checklists, named "Ver. 12.3 August 2020" and "Ver. 3.3 August 2020" respectively.
- Existing inspections with "In Progress" status which have been edited by Inspectors at least once prior to this system release, will appear with the previous JIG 1/2 or JIG 4 checklist versions and will be completed using that version. Please note that it is acceptable to complete an inspection using the version that was in use when the inspection was started. For these inspections, the inspectors are requested **not** to press the "Reverify" button.
- Inspectors who wish to submit JIG 1/2 or JIG 4 inspection reports using the current 12.2 and 3.2 checklist versions respectively, are kindly requested to progress these inspections **as soon as possible** to "In Progress" status, and to initially verify the location's profile (first mandatory action after pressing Fill in the report) prior to the new versions' release date, so that they will be able to use the previous checklist versions to submit those reports.

The objective of this update is to include the requirements listed in JIG Bulletin 130, which introduces Dirt Defence Filtration (DDF) in conjunction with electronic Water Sensor (EWS) into the JIG Standards, including:

- Applications where DDF or DDF+EWS Technology may be used
- Installation & Commissioning
- Operations & Operating protocol
- DDF Element commissioning and routine maintenance
- Documentation & Records
