### **Introduction**

The Swanbourne House Accessibility Plan has been produced in line with paragraph 3 of Schedule 10 to the Equality Act 2010. Our plan includes intentions for improving the physical environment of the school for the purpose of increasing the extent to which disabled pupils are able to take advantage of education, benefits, facilities and services provided or offered by the school. The plans also covers participation in curriculum by, and delivery of information to, disabled pupils.

The plan complements the school's Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) Policy, Equal Opportunities Policy, and Health and Safety Policy, and forms part of our commitment to removing barriers to learning and participation.

### **Aims**

Our aims are to:

- Identify and remove barriers to accessibility wherever reasonable.
- Increase the participation of pupils with disabilities in the life of the school.
- Develop staff awareness and confidence in supporting pupils with additional needs.
- Ensure that information is accessible to all pupils and parents.
- Monitor and review progress towards greater accessibility.

Objectives will be set over a three-year period and reviewed annually.

## **Current Position**

### **Access to the Curriculum**

- Differentiated curriculum planning across departments
- Staff regularly trained in SEND and reasonable adjustments
- Individual Education Plans (IEPs) and In Class Support Documents (ICSD) in place
- Assistive technology available (laptops)
- Exam access arrangements carefully planned and delivered
- Laptop use below Year 7 when appropriate
- Laptop club to assist those using laptops as part of a SEND

### **Access to the Physical Environment**

- Ramps to main entrances or additional entrances to allow access
- Accessible toilet facilities
- Car park includes a designated disabled space
- Some upper classrooms only accessible via stairs

- Website compliant with accessibility standards (WCAG 2.1 AA)
- Alternative formats available on request
- Newsletters emailed in accessible PDF format
- Large print and visual timetables used if required
